Terri Long MPT, is a licensed physical therapist with extensive experience providing hippotherapy and therapeutic services for over 25 years to a wide variety of clients. She has specialized in working with people with neurological disabilities especially traumatic brain injury. Terri supervised Bryn Mawr Rehab's hippotherapy program at Thorncroft Equestrian Center for eight years. During this time she organized two conferences to educate therapists on the importance of hippotherapy as a treatment tool for clients with brain injuries. After seeing the significant improvements the horse had on the riders Terri started her own program in the rural area she grew up in when she moved home with her husband to start a family.

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TaKE Center is an outpatient rehabilitative service provider that offers both hippotherapy and therapeutic sessions to clients from 2-89 years old. The center sits on 44 peaceful acres that have been in the family for generations. TaKE center started in 2001 with just 6 riders and 3 horses. Since then, the Upper Bucks County facility has expended to over 30 riders per week with 6 horses supporting the program.

Terri is a member of both the American Hippotherapy Association (AHA) and the Professional Association of Therapeutic Horsemanship international (PATH). She lives on the property in Kintnersville, PA with her husband and 2 children. She works as a physical therapist besides running TaKE Center and working with her riding students.
