He led Opiant's development of nasal naloxone for opioid overdose, which led to FDA approval, and is the lead inventor on the product's patents. He served as the Chief Business Officer for ImaginAb, a Los Angeles based venture capital backed biotechnology company, leading the company's turnaround around its immuno-oncology platform and managed its pharmaceutical company partnerships and licensing deals. He was responsible for acquisitions, licensing and partnering deals at GE Healthcare. He began his business career working for Goldman Sachs in Mergers and Acquisitions and as a management consultant at A.T. Kearney specializing in healthcare strategy.
